<p>On page 77, Chapter 4 Medical Benefits Chart, under the section “Medicare Part B prescription drugs” your Evidence of Coverage lists your cost share as:</p>	<p>20% coinsurance for Medicare-covered Part B drugs, including chemotherapy drugs.</p>	<p>20% coinsurance for Medicare-covered Part B drugs, including chemotherapy drugs.</p> <p>Effective April 1, 2023, Part B rebatable drugs will not exceed the coinsurance amount of the original Medicare adjusted coinsurance for the Part B rebatable drug.</p> <p>Effective July 1, 2023, \$35 copayment for a one-month supply of Part B insulin.</p>	<p>April 1, 2023, some Part B rebatable drugs may result in a lower coinsurance of 20%.</p> <p>July 1, 2023, Part B insulin you will not pay more than a \$35 copayment for a one-month supply.</p>
